

LESSON 3: RESOURCE 5

Conscience Alley

1. Walk the Tunnel or Thought Channel:

Two rows of students opposite each other and they have opposing views on the topics of marrying someone outside a religious faith, or arranged marriages, or obeying one's parents totally, for example. One pupil has got to walk through the tunnel listening to the views and at the end has to state which side he/she is going to join. If not, they have to put up a very good counter argument.

2. Hot seating:

One person agrees to put them selves into another person's shoes and questions are fired at them. They have to imagine they are that person and what they think they might say in certain situations.
